PRE-SCHOOL REMINDERS

Sickness/upset stomach – Please keep your child out of pre-school for 48hrs after sickness and ensure they are fit and well before returning.

Coughs - Infections are spread in many ways but most illness spread by coughs. Coughing spreads lots of germs. If your child is coughing a lot please keep them out of pre-school and inform us they are unwell.

Polite Reminder - Please do not put your child's name down for after school clubs/discos without paying first. We have had a few issues previously of names being put down and then non payments and wasting spaces as this is limited to 15 children meaning others miss out if people don't show up. We really enjoy being able to offer these after school activities and we have to make sure we have the right ratio. Thank you for your understanding.

Please remember...

Toilet – Please ensure your child visits the toilet at home before arriving at pre-school.

Named belongings – please ensure you label your child's belongings with big and bold names so staff can find lunch boxes, bags, clothes etc easily.

Snacks – Please provide a morning and/or afternoon snack of fruit or vegetables.

Cut fruit – Please cut fruit and veg up into small pieces to reduce the risk of choking e.g. tomatoes, carrots etc. Grapes need to be cut lengthways.

Drinks – Please can we ask that only water is sent in to pre-school in water bottles.

Car parking and safety – Please be extremely careful when driving near pre-school.
